General

The Trustees are keen for each applicant to make as strong an application as possible.

In order to complete the *online* application successfully, please attend to the following instructions:

1. Applicants must enter their responses in one session as there is no option to save responses for completion at a later session.
2. Scrolling through the application questions in advance is highly recommended.
3. Prepare longer text responses in advance in a Word document: Applicants can copy and paste responses into the text boxes when appropriate.
4. As applicants will be required to upload attachments, the form needs to be completed from a Mac or PC as mobile devices and tablets are not compatible: Attachments must be in PDF format and smaller than 10MB each.
5. Please answer every section: use nil or N/A rather than leave a blank.
6. Multiple applications will not be considered.
7. An attachment checklist has been provided at the end of this document to assist applicants' documentation preparation.

If you include a stamped addressed envelope or packet of adequate size, material will be returned; otherwise, it will be available for collection from NIDA after you are informed of the Trustees' decision. If not collected within one month from that time, it may be destroyed. Send copies of attached documents and photographs only, not originals.

1. Eligibility

To be eligible, you **must** be a resident of Australia. In addition, you **must** fulfill one, or both, of the following criteria:

- You are *either* a graduate of a full-time acting course, or a graduate of a full-time directing course, at a recognised tertiary institution
- You have worked **substantially** and **professionally** as an **actor** and/or a **director** for at least two years

Experience other than as an arts professional, such as undergraduate university coursework majoring in drama or theatre studies, secondary (school) drama studies, and amateur experience will not be considered.

It may be helpful to know that successful applicants to date have satisfied both the criteria listed previously. The Fellowships are intended for actors and directors who have started to make their mark, or for those who already have a substantial professional career in the entertainment arts and who want to refresh or to change direction. However, if you are eligible, and want to apply, do not be deterred.

2. Capacity

This refers to whether your proposed project relates to acting and/or to directing rather than your past training and/or experience. Applications in any other capacity (e.g., writer, producer) are ineligible and will be rejected.

3. Previous overseas experience

Other things being equal, the Trustees will prefer, in accordance with the wishes of Gloria Payten and Gloria Dawn, someone who has never travelled overseas. However, please note that several Fellows had previously travelled outside Australia. Do not apply if your proposal, or any part of it, involves travel etc *within* Australia.

4. Curriculum Vitae

A comprehensive, up-to-date, and clearly presented CV is essential. For one way of presenting it, please see this sample CV: <https://www.nida.edu.au/alumni-and-industry/fellowships/glorias>

5. Statement of proposed use of Fellowship

Please allow adequate preparation time.

The best applications show forethought and evidence of the following, where applicable:

- Research (e.g. sourcing content and dates of courses and festivals, accommodation, associated costs, exchange rates, etc.)
- Correspondence (mail, e-mail, social media interaction) with overseas individuals, companies, institutions, etc...
- Letter of acceptance into a course, or as an observer with a company
- Letters of support relating to the proposed project
- Supporting material (five pages maximum): Photocopies (not transcripts) of reviews, information re the course.

It is in your interest to be concise.

Do not try to fit too much into your proposal.

The Trustees take into account the relevance of your proposal to your work on your return.

6. Estimated cost of proposal

N.B. (a) to (h) and (k) are essential; (i) to (l) are optional. Contingency of 10% is recommended.

You are not expected to stay at the Y and starve. Be realistic: research the costs of accommodation, meals, travel, etc. (visit relevant websites to source information). Quote costs in AUD throughout. If you have accommodation that is free (e.g. with friends), or that is included in course costs, note this in your budget. The most frequent failings when completing this section are omitting entries, poor correlation to details of proposal, underestimating costs, mixing \$AUD with other currencies not following guidelines, miscalculation, and fudging.

7. Referees

The Trustees seek professional, rather than personal, referees and considerable importance is attached to which referees you choose to submit. It is in your interest to find referees of some standing in the entertainment arts who know your work well. It is **essential** that you inform each of your referees of your proposed use of the Fellowship. While written references are not essential, a signed dated reference on company or personal letterhead (where appropriate), **submitted as a PDF online, or in the case of a postal application, a photocopy**, that endorses both applicant and proposal is particularly helpful to the Trustees.
