This is a reimagining of the world of *The Effect*. Exploring perspective, manipulation & beytral expressed as live performance & video storytelling. The intersection of meaning created from fragmentation, jutxaposition and simultanous storytelling is ever present.

What is reality when the composition of our brains are altered? Our perspectives are ever shifting so how easily can these be manipulated? All we have left is the truth.

DESIGNER'S NOTE

Designing for *The Effect*, collaboration for the creative team was paramount; We aspired to create a world using the visual and auditory senses of the audience to make the feeling an uneasy one. The set and costume create a solitary and bounded world devoid of life and warmth, whilst the lighting, video, and soundtrack the progression of Connie and Tristan's worsening mental and emotional state becoming more unstable, chaotic and oppressive throughout. The Effect affects the viewer as they struggle to ground themselves within a world without stability.
